#### Philippians 1:1-2

<sup>1</sup> This letter is from Paul and Timothy, servants of Christ Jesus. I am writing to all of God's holy people in Philippi who belong to Christ Jesus, including the church leaders and deacons. <sup>2</sup> May God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ give you grace and peace.



Galatians 6:3


If you think you are too important to help someone, you are only fooling yourself.
